



JOB TITLE: Electrician

ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE: Reports to the Maintenance Manager.

FLSA STATUS: Non- Exempt

DEPARTMENT: Maintenance

POSITION SUMMARY: This position is responsible for park electrical systems and facilities to ensure a safe operation. This position will focus on repair, construction, troubleshooting and rehab of park rides and facilities and help to establish preventive maintenance and inspection.

KEY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Install, control and distribute apparatus such as switches, relays and circuit breaker panels.
- Testing of circuits to ensure electrical compatibility and safety of components.
- Perform preventative maintenance, repairs, and overhauls on rides, equipment and facilities ensuring complete compliance of the manufacturer's specifications and park standards.
- Communicate with Dispatch Office and the Maintenance team when equipment failures resort in closures.
- Work with team members to ensure the complete compliance of the manufacturer's specifications and park standards.
- Maintaining all appropriate documentation.
- Communicate with the Maintenance Manager any hazards that arise to ensure the safe completion of repairs.
- Assist the Water Park maintenance team with projects as needed.
- Be a proactive member of the maintenance team.
- Must be able to work varied shifts, including holidays and weekends.
- Other duties as assigned.

SKILLS, REQUIREMENTS, AND QUALIFICATIONS:

- 3 – 8 years of previous maintenance experience; experience in an Amusement park setting desired.
- Must have a valid WA driver's license.
- Maintain valid Electrician License.
- Knowledge of electric control systems, devices, PLCs, and fundamental electronic principles.
- Must have skills and knowledge of mechanical, pneumatics, hydraulics.
- Communicate effectively and appropriately with all guests, co-workers and management.
- Must be a self-starter, able to multi-task, work independently and have a positive attitude.
- Ability to trouble-shoot problems and present solutions for a variety of situations. Ability to interpret a variety of instructions furnished in written, oral, diagram, or schedule form.
- General math skills including, but not limited to basic algebra, addition, subtraction, multiplication, division and the ability to read measurements.
- Commitment to company values.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS: The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

- While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to use hands to finger, handle, or feel; reach with hands and arms; and talk or hear. The employee frequently is required to stand; walk; and stoop, kneel, crouch or crawl. The employee is occasionally required to sit and climb or balance. The employee must regularly lift and/or move up to thirty pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception, and ability to adjust focus.
- Work environment: While performing the duties of this job, the employee is exposed to weather conditions prevalent at the time. The noise level is generally moderate to high.
