

JOB TITLE: Water Park Maintenance Supervisor
ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE: Reports to the Director of Maintenance
FLSA STATUS: Exempt
DEPARTMENT: Maintenance



POSITION SUMMARY: This position is responsible for maintenance of all equipment to ensure a safe operation of the Water Park. This position will focus on repair, construction, general upkeep, troubleshooting and rehab of water park rides and attractions and help to establish preventive maintenance and inspection programs that maximize uptime and minimize cost.

KEY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Maintaining the highest standards of safety on all attractions and rides.
- Ensure the proper functioning of the pumps, filters, plumbing systems.
- Perform daily safety checks on park attractions and rides and attend to any repairs.
- Perform regular checks of pools and perform chemical adjustments to ensure a safe environment that comply with standards.
- Perform preventative maintenance, repairs, and overhauls on rides, equipment and facilities ensuring complete compliance of the manufacturer's specifications and park standards.
- Responding to all maintenance related radio calls in a timely and appropriate manner. Communicate with Dispatch Office and the Maintenance team when equipment failures result in attraction downtime or closures.
- Work with team members to ensure the complete compliance of the manufacturer's specifications and park standards.
- Maintaining all appropriate documentation.
- Communicate with the Water Park Maintenance Team and Director of Maintenance any hazards that arise to ensure the safe completion of repairs.
- Assist the dry park maintenance team with projects as needed.
- Assist with holiday promotion set-up, repairs and tear-down.
- Be a proactive member of the maintenance team.
- Must be able to work varied shifts, including holidays and weekends.
- Other duties as assigned.

SKILLS, REQUIREMENTS, AND QUALIFICATIONS:

- 5+ years of previous pool maintenance experience; experience in an Amusement park setting desired.
- 3+ years of supervisory experience
- Must have a valid WA driver's license.
- Must have skills and knowledge of pumps, hydraulics, filtration and drainage systems.
- Must be comfortable performing duties in water at a depth of up to 12 ft.
- CPO certification or ability to obtain upon hire.
- Fiberglass repair skills, a plus.
- Communicate effectively and appropriately with all guests, co-workers and management.
- Must be a self-starter, able to multi-task, work independently and have a positive attitude.
- Ability to trouble-shoot problems and present solutions for a variety of situations. Ability to interpret a variety of instructions furnished in written, oral, diagram, or schedule form.
- General math skills including, but not limited to basic algebra, addition, subtraction, multiplication, division and the ability to read measurements.
- Commitment to company values.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS: The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

- While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to use hands to finger, handle, or feel; reach with hands and arms; and talk or hear. The employee frequently is required to stand; walk; and stoop, kneel, crouch or crawl. The employee is occasionally required to sit and climb or balance. The employee must regularly lift and/or move up to thirty pounds, frequently lift and/or move up to fifty pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception, and ability to adjust focus.
- Work environment: While performing the duties of this job, the employee is exposed to weather conditions prevalent at the time. The noise level is generally moderate to high.
