POSITION SUMMARY: This position is responsible for the maintenance and aesthetics of the park landscape. This position will focus on the upkeep of flower beds, natural landscape and lawn areas.

KEY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Daily Maintenance and upkeep of vegetation, including mowing, planting, digging, pruning and general clean-up.
- Maintaining the general landscape of the park, including flower beds, walkways, lawn and natural wooded areas.
- Responsible for development and upkeep of general park aesthetic.
- Assist with Holiday Promotions event set-up.
- Other Duties as assigned

SKILLS, REQUIREMENTS AND QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be 18 years or older with a valid WA state driver's license.
- Ability to work long shifts and various schedules.
- 2 – 3 years of landscaping experience
- Experience with irrigation a plus.
- Ability to communicate effectively, appropriately and professionally with guests, co-workers and management
- Ability to perform various physical tasks, including lifting, crawling, walking and crouching, while operating basic tools and machinery.
- Must be a self-starter, able to multi-task, able to work independently and have a positive attitude.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS:
