The Fun is Back! Wild Waves Theme & Water Park Counts Down to Opening Day

Park Opens Friday, June 18th

Federal Way, WA (May 19, 2021) – The fun is back! After being unable to open for the 2020 season due to COVID-19, Wild Waves Theme & Water Park will finally open on June 18 for a season of fresh air and fun with friends and family! The park has prepared a vigorous health and safety protocol designed to provide Washingtonians with a safe, close-to-home way to get outdoors and make new memories. Season Passes and tickets purchased in 2020 will be honored in 2021. At this time, the park is still required to have capacity restrictions. All guests are required to make a reservation online prior to their visit June 18th through June 30th. As restrictions and guidelines are eased, we will reevaluate and work toward resuming normal operations.

“Our team is counting down the days and has put an incredible amount of time and planning into preparing Wild Waves for the 2021 season and we are ready to welcome guests with safe, clean, outdoor entertainment,” said Jody Kneupper, Park President at Wild Waves Theme & Water Park. “We want guests to know how excited we are to have them back. We encourage everyone to visit WildWaves.com when planning their outing, looking for a job or grabbing the best deal on tickets.”

The park has also extended new benefits to 2020 Season Pass holders who purchased a 2020 Season Pass. All 2020 Season Pass holders have automatically been upgraded to the new Premium Season Pass, which features several new benefits, including free parking. All 2020 tickets and Season Passes will be honored in 2021. No action is required to be valid for the 2021 season. Early Season Pass processing will take place June 3 – 5, 10 -12, 16 – 17 from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. and feature a new drive-thru process.

Information regarding Wild Waves Theme & Water Park’s safety and health precautions, reservations, and early processing can be found on the park’s website, by following the park on social media, or signing up for the newsletter.

Some of the new health and safety precautions include:

- Managing Attendance Capacity (until restrictions are still in place)
 - To provide safe outdoor entertainment and maintain social distancing guidelines, we are reducing and managing our daily capacity with a new reservations system.

- Face Mask / Face Covering Required
 - Face masks are not required for fully vaccinated employees and guests.
 - Face masks are not required by guests while in the water or on water slides.

- Social Distancing Throughout The Property
 - Guests will be required to maintain a proper distance from other guests who are not in their party. Signs and ground markers will be displayed throughout the theme and water park.

- Increased Sanitization
 - Additional hand sanitizing stations have been added to public areas, and other high traffic locations.
 - Increased frequency of cleaning high-touch areas and seating such as railings, queue areas, food stands and seating.
