Wild Waves Theme & Water Park Prepares for 2021 Season with Virtual Hiring Event March 24

Washington's only theme and water park has to fill 600 positions

Federal Way, WA (March 18, 2021) – With 600 positions to fill for the 2021 season, Wild Waves Theme & Water Park will be hosting a virtual hiring event on Wednesday, March 24 from 10am-5pm. Interested candidates can choose from guest service roles in areas including admissions, aquatics, rides, food service, retail, guest relations and park services. Once scheduled for their preferred timeslot, applicants will proceed to take place in virtual group interviews on Wednesday, March 24, allowing them to interact with park supervisors and other applicants, providing a unique opportunity to showcase their personality and learn more about the park environment. Applicants must register on the park's website by 5pm on Monday, March 22.

These roles are appropriate for applicants at any skill level, with competitive hourly pay, opportunity for promotion, and unique benefits - including free park admission, flexible schedules, and a fun work environment. The minimum age to apply is 16 and pay starts at \$13.75 an hour.

"I started my amusement industry career as a teenager, lifeguarding at a water park," said Wild Waves Theme & Water Park Park President, Jody Kneupper. "The experience and leadership skills I gained helped me succeed in college and eventually took me all over the country with an amazing opportunity to see new places and have fun at work. It's a career I could have never imagined."

Candidates unable to attend the virtual hiring event on March 24 can still apply online at wildwaves.com/jobs. Applications are reviewed daily with interviews and job offers taking place weekly.

Pending state and local approval, Wild Waves Theme & Water Park is preparing to open on June 18 with new health and safety protocols in place, following recommendations from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA), as well as amusement and water park industry best practices. The park has also created a webpage dedicated to health and safety. Guests are encouraged to visit wildwaves.com/covid19.php prior to their visit.

All 2020 Wild Waves Season Passes have been converted and upgraded to the new 2021 Premium Season Pass which includes free season parking and 50% off cabana rental.
